Weatherization Assistance Program

What Is Weatherization?

Weatherization is the process by which homes are made more energy efficient. This result is accomplished through a series of relatively easy energy conservation measures. Homes that have been weatherized require less energy to heat and cool, resulting in lower utility bills and a higher standard of living.

The CSRA Economic Opportunity Authority Inc. increases the energy efficiency of dwellings owned or occupied by low-income persons. The Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) uses Whole House Weatherization, which treats the house as a single energy-consuming system, rather than a loose collection of unrelated pieces of equipment. This requires advanced diagnostic skills and cost-effective measure selection and installation. These conservation measures result in energy and cost savings. Single-family homes, multifamily buildings, and manufactured homes are eligible.

How to Apply for Weatherization:

Step One: Download an application at our website www.csraeo.org or call our office at (706) 945-1616

Step Two: If you qualify, an energy audit will be conducted on your home, which includes evaluating energy-related health and safety conditions. Following the audit, energy-efficiency measures will be completed.

Step Three: After acceptance into the program and initial evaluations, weatherization contractors will install the most cost-effective energy efficiency measures.

Due to high demand, there may be a waiting list.

Energy-efficiency measures performed through the program may include, but are not limited to:

- Air and duct sealing
- Wall, floor, and attic insulation
- Heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system improvements
- Energy efficiency improvements in lighting
- Hot water tank and pipe insulation
